

Strong Magnets! Please Read!



The neodymium magnets we sell are extremely strong, and must be handled with care to avoid personal injury and damage to the magnets. Fingers and other body parts can get severely pinched between two attracting magnets. Neodymium magnets are brittle, and can peel, crack or shatter if allowed to slam together. Eye protection should be worn when handling these magnets, because shattering magnets can launch pieces at great speeds. Do not ingest or inhale these magnets. Ingestion or inhalation of these magnets may result in injury or death.



THESE MAGNETS ARE NOT A TOY. Children should not be allowed to handle neodymium magnets as they can be dangerous. Small magnets post a choking hazard and should never be swallowed or inserted into any part of the body. Swallowed magnets can stick together across intestines causing serious infections and death. Seek immediate medical attention if magnets are swallowed or inhaled.



Never allow neodymium magnets near a person with a pacemaker or similar medical aid. The strong magnetic fields of the magnet can affect the operation of such devices, **which may result in injury or even death**.



The strong magnetic fields of neodymium magnets can also damage magnetic data storage media and electronic devices. Keep these magnets away from credit cards, computer disks, video tapes, and other magnetic media. Never place these magnets near televisions, VCRs, computer monitors, or other electronic equipment.



Do not machine, cut, or drill neodymium magnets. These magnets are brittle and prone to chipping and cracking. Do not burn these magnets, as burning them will create toxic fumes.



Neodymium magnets will lose their magnetic properties if heated above 175° (80°C)
